- Strict cleaning processes and procedures of clinical—and nonclinical areas.
 - Non-clinical:
 - Frequency:
 - If sneezing or coughing occurs that exposes surface areas to possible contaminants
 - When visible soil is present
 - Once between opening and lunch
 - Prior to going to lunch
 - Once between lunch and COB
 - Close of Business
 - Locations:
 - Store front, Lobby, Reception, Offices, Exam rooms, Conference room, Hallways, Sterilization, Labs, X-ray Room, Pan/Ceph Rooms, Supply rooms, Mop Sink rooms.
 - Restrooms
 - Break Room
 - Clinical:
 - Full disinfection of clinical spaces
 - Allow spaces to be dormant for extended periods of time in areas where aerosols may be produced
